# ACA Hands-on Activities

#### Open Start01.psd.

- 1. Select layers 1 and 2. Align Horizontal Centers.
- 2. Select layer 3 and apply the Nebula Style to the layer.
- 3. Select the vertical type tool and type Adobe on the right side of the screen. Your font should be Adobe Garamond Pro, Bold, 50pt, black.
- 4. Place the embedded flower.jpg file below the pink rectangle

Save as ACA1.psd in your network folder

# Open Start02.jpg

- 1. Make the image black---and---white non-destructively, adjusting the resulting levels automatically.
- 2. Adjust the canvas width by two inches so that the new canvas is on the left side of the image.

# Save as ACA2.psd

### Open Start03.jpg

- 1. Add a new Solid Fill layer (green: 16,192,61)
- 2. Drop the opacity to 60%.
- 3. Add a new layer
- 4. Add a red (255,0,0) rectangle (200px x 100px) to the image.
- 5. Apply the Color Target (Button) Style to the rectangle.
- 6. Edit the layer style. Remove the Gradient Overlay.

### Save as ACA3.psd

Close all Docs before starting

- 1. Reset your Essentials Workspace. Display the rulers.
- 2. Move the Layers panel and place it between the Color and Libraries panels.
- 3. Dock the Channels panel and place it within the Libraries panel. Save your new workspace as **ACA Practice**.
- 4. Press the Print Screen key on your <u>keyboard</u> to take a screenshot of your new workspace. Use the Snip & Sketch tool to take your screenshot.
- 5. Go to File>New. Accept the default settings. Ctrl V to paste your screenshot into the image.

Save as **ACA4.psd** in your network folder.
